**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
of  
**FREEDOM OF RELIGION FOUNDATION - EAST TENNESSEE**

For the purpose of forming a corporation under the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act,  
the undersigned executes the following Articles of Incorporation:

**ARTICLE 1**  
**NAME**

The name of the Corporation is "**Freedom From Religion Foundation - East Tennessee**" or "**FFRF - East Tennessee**," hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation."

**ARTICLE 2**  
**EXISTENCE**

The Corporation is created as a nonprofit, nonstock Tennessee corporation under Title 48, Chapters 51-68, of the Tennessee Code Annotated. The period of the Corporation's existence is perpetual.

**ARTICLE 3**  
**PURPOSES**

3.1 The Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The specific purposes shall include to promote nontheism and defend the constitutional separation between religion and government.

3.2 The Corporation is expressly prohibited from engaging in any activity that would be inconsistent with the status of an educational and charitable organization as defined in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

**ARTICLE 4**  
**POWERS**

The Corporation has all powers now or in the future given by law to nonstock corporations organized under the laws of Tennessee; provided, however, that such powers may be exercised only to further the purposes stated in Article 3 above, and further provided that:

4.1 No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the Corporation is authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 3 above;

4.2 No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation;

4.3 The Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office; and,

4.4 Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

**ARTICLE 5**  
**MEMBERSHIP**

The Corporation shall not have members.

**ARTICLE 6**  
**BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The method of electing Directors of the Corporation shall be stated in the Bylaws of the Corporation. The number of Directors shall be fixed by the Bylaws of the Corporation, but the number of Directors shall not be fewer than three.

**ARTICLE 7  
DISSOLUTION**

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation to the Freedom From Religion Foundation, provided that it continues to be recognized as an organization that is exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Code. If it cannot accept the assets, the distribution shall be made to such organization or organizations that are organized and operated exclusively for exempt purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, or to a State or a political subdivision of a State as defined in section 170(c)(1) of the Code.
